## Purpose

1. The purpose of this paper is to present a draft workplan for the Compliance Monitoring Scheme Intersessional Working Group (CMS IWG) in 2022 and beyond, for consideration by WCPFC18. The draft workplan was prepared in response to the following TCC17 recommendation (TCC17 Summary Report, paragraph 112):

112. TCC17 noted the need for a clear pathway to progress the work of the CMS-IWG and tasked the CMS-IWG Chair (the TCC Vice Chair) to work with the leads of the work streams to provide advice to WCPFC18 on a workplan for the IWG for 2022.

- 2. The workplan was developed in consultation with the Secretariat and the respective leads on the development of a risk based assessment framework and the development of audit points. The objective of the workplan is to develop a clear timeline of the anticipated work of the CMS IWG in order to complete the tasks included in the CMS future work plan, as outlined in Section IX of CMM 2019-06.
