Considerable planning and liaison (at all levels of administration) with WCPFC members are required annually for the successful implementation of the <u>WCPFC Pacific Tuna Tagging Programme (WCPFC-PTTP) and other associated research activities.</u> To assist with the operational planning of the WCPFC-PTTP SPC would like to establish an Advisory Committee comprising of participants with an interest or function in the annual implementation of PTTP Research Cruises. The Advisory Committee will assist with organising the logistics associated with cruise implementation and also provide input into and planning guidance for future research activities and priorities. Annex 1

Terms of Reference WCPFC Pacific Tuna Tagging Programme Cruise Planning Advisory Committee

<u>Purpose</u>

This is a voluntary Advisory Committee organised and managed by SPC. It is not a formal meeting of the WCPFC. It is established to assist SPC and WCPFC members with undertaking yearly <u>PTTP Research Cruise</u> planning and implementation. The Committee's role is Advisory only. Participants will contribute to setting cruise operational objectives (e.g. cruise options within EEZs), facilitating permits and access to bait grounds, developing beneficial collaborations with industry, and organising participation by national officers and observers, within the monetary, logistical and technical constraints inherent within the PTTP. The Committee will also contribute to tag recovery strategies and assist with fostering productive collaborations to enhance participation by WCPFC members in the work plan of the PTTP (including dialogue between WCPFC associated programmes).

Committee Procedures

- The Advisory Committee will meet <u>electronically</u> using virtual meeting tools such as Zoom and Microsoft Teams.
- SPC will <u>chair</u> the meeting and provide a summary report after each meeting to all registered Advisory Committee members, including those unable to attend. A compilation of the reports will be an Annex of the Annual Report of the PTTP and included as an Agenda item of the PTTP Steering Committee.
- Membership of the Committee is open to <u>all members of WCPFC, WCPFC observers and invited</u> <u>experts.</u>
- The Advisory Committee will work within the <u>annual mandate of the PTTP</u> set by the PTTP Steering Committee and WCPFC Science Committee.
