**TCC18 Provisional Agenda and Meeting Preparations**

Dear Colleagues,

Following the Commission's decision to convene an online meeting for TCC18 ([Circular 2022/39](#)), I am pleased to invite Members, Cooperating Non-Members, Participating Territories (CCMs) and Observers to participate in the online Eighteenth Session of the Technical and Compliance Committee from 21 to 27 September 2022. Participants are requested to register for the online TCC18 meeting at the following link: <https://meetings.wcpfc.int/meetings/tcc18>

I have worked with the TCC Vice Chair and the Secretariat to develop a Provisional Agenda for TCC18 ([WCPFC-TCC18-2022-02](#)), attached to this circular and also posted to the TCC18 meeting page <https://meetings.wcpfc.int/meetings/tcc18> with the circulation of this circular.

CCMs will recall that WCPFC18, in extending the Compliance Monitoring Scheme CMM for a further two years ([CMM 2021-03](#)), agreed to defer the Compliance Monitoring Report (CMR) assessment review process (provisional CMR and final CMR process) in 2022 so that TCC can dedicate appropriate time to the completion of CMS Future Work components (WCPFC18 summary report, para 92i). As such, the TCC18 agenda and schedule will look a little different to previous meetings.

I note that the CMS-IWG Chair, TCC Vice Chair Emily Crigler, along with the leads on the audit points and risk-based assessment framework (RBAF) workstreams, Rhea Moss-Christian and Heather Ward respectively, have provided advice on the process for this important work in the lead up to TCC18 (refer [Circular 2022/35](#)). I commend the leadership of Emily, Rhea and Heather and I strongly encourage all CCMs to actively engage in this work to ensure that TCC can make significant progress on these bodies of work, and the broader CMS reform work this year. I am particularly keen for TCC18 to be able to provide clear advice to the Commission on how all the aspects of the CMS will fit together for the implementation of an effective CMR review process in 2023. I also note that a number of

other issues on the TCC18 agenda, in particular the work of the ERandEMWG, will be relevant to the critical CMS reform work.

I am working with the CMS-IWG Chair, the Audit Point and RBAF leads, and the Secretariat to consider how to most effectively structure the TCC18 schedule to progress this work – hence I will provide advice on the meeting arrangements, including meeting timing, within the coming weeks.

### *Online Discussion Forum*

Once again, the Online Discussion Forum (ODF) will be a critical part of the delivery of TCC18.

The ODF will commence one month before TCC18 (Monday 22 August 2022) and will provide an important platform for preparatory and supplementary work that will enable us to best utilise the limited time available in the Zoom plenary. A list of TCC18 ODF topics will be provided prior to commencement of the forum, but in summary:

- The regular reports that the Secretariat prepares (including the Executive Director's Annual Report) will be included in the ODF with issues to be raised to plenary by exception only.
- Consideration of Cooperating Non-Member (CNM) applications will be undertaken through the ODF and reported to plenary.
- Delegation papers or proposals may be considered through the ODF.

As with last year, there will be opportunity for plenary discussion of ODF items where necessary under relevant agenda items.

**I would welcome nominations for a chair for the CNM-SWG by Friday 19 August 2022.** The CNM-SWG Chair will facilitate ODF consideration of CNM applications and prepare recommendations for consideration by the TCC18 plenary.

CCMs are requested to **provide delegation papers/proposals and/or requests for additional ODF topics** at least 30 days ahead of the meeting, such that **by Sunday 21 August 2022.**

- Where a CCM requests creation of an ODF topic, they will be responsible for facilitating discussion and presenting summary of discussions and proposed recommendations to plenary where required.

The TCC18 ODF will remain open through the TCC18 meeting to facilitate meeting discussions.

TCC18 participants must be registered and approved for the TCC18 meeting in order to participate in the ODF. Support for registrations and using Zoom is available from the [Online Meeting Resources](#) helpdesk.

*Break-out meetings*

As with the virtual meetings undertaken last year, there is some capacity for break-out Zoom sessions to be convened on specific issues, however opportunities will be very limited and reserved for high priority issues.

*TCC18 Heads of Delegation meeting*

As per standard practice, I seek to convene a meeting of TCC18 Heads of Delegations (HODs) the day before TCC18 (Tuesday 20 September from 4 to 5:30pm Pohnpei time) to confirm key details ahead of the commencement of TCC. An agenda for this meeting will be provided in due course.
