The Eighth Joint IATTC and WCPFC-NC Working Group Meeting on the Management of Pacific Bluefin Tuna (JWG-08) will be held at the Hilton Fukuoka Sea Hawk, Fukuoka, Japan, from 4 to 5 July 2023. Prior to JWG-08, there will be the 4^{th} Joint Working Group on Catch Documentation Scheme (JWG-CDS) Technical Meeting at 9:00am on the 3^{rd} of July, with registration for both JWG-CDS and JWG-08 meetings starting at 8:15am. The JWG-08 meeting will start at 9:00am on 4-5 July, chaired by Co-Chairs Dorothy Lowman (USA) and Masanori Miyahara (Japan). Subject to the JWG-CDS meeting progress, JWG-08 may start on the 3^{rd} of July, which will be advised in due course.

Each delegation that applies for a Japanese visa is kindly requested to send (a) the information listed in the Attachment 1, (b) a copy of your passport and (c) a copy of note verbal from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your country (unless you are general passport holder applying for a short-term visa) to the meeting coordinator, Mr. Masahide KANNOU (masahide kanno210@maff.go.jp) and Mr. Issei SHIRAKAWA (issei_shirakawa580@maff.go.jp), via e-mail by 19th April 2023. Fisheries Agency of Japan will use them to communicate with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan so that it can send a formal instruction to the Embassy or Consulate General of Japan for a smooth issuance of your visa.

Should you need a letter of invitation, letter of guarantee, and/or list of visa applicants etc. from the host country, please inform so when you send aforementioned email to the meeting coordinator.

Climate

Early July is the start of summer and at the end of rainy season in Japan, so it is hot and humid. Historical average temperature in Fukuoka is 27°C (24-30°C) during the meeting period.

Funding for Developing Countries and Territories

According to the decision made by WCPFC9, six small island developing States would be funded for travel to the JWG-08 meeting including the NC19 meeting (3 – 7 July 2023), with priority given to RMI, FSM and Palau. These are in addition to the Cook Islands, Fiji and Vanuatu who are Members of the Northern Committee. Formal nominations for participants to receive this support should be submitted to the Secretariat (<u>Aaron.Nighswander@wcpfc.int</u>) by 1 June 2023 under the signature of their WCPFC Official Contact for eligible developing countries and participating territories.

The latest travel arrangements for nominees should be finalized, two weeks prior to commencing travel.

COVID Protocols

Participants are encouraged to wear masks in the meeting room of NC19 and its associated meetings to protect the health of the participants.

Accommodation Options

Large public events (the Swimming World Championships and Hakata Gion Yamakasa Local Festival) are scheduled in Fukuoka at around the meeting dates. <u>It is advisable that participants make a reservation for accommodation earlier</u>.

Accommodation around the meeting venue is limited. However, a number of accommodation options are available in downtown Fukuoka, in Hakata and Tenjin Area (over 60 hotels), with reasonable access to the meeting venue.



Transportation Options


1) Direction from Tenjin Area to Hilton Fukuoka Sea Hawk



By Bus: From Tenjin, get on the bus bound for "Fukuoka Tower TNC (#W1)" at "Tenjin Bus Center" bus stop and get off at "Hilton Fukuoka Sea Hawk-mae" bus stop. The hotel is a one-minute walk from the bus stop. Approximately 17-minute ride from the bus stop.

By subway: Take the Fukuoka City Subway, getting off at "Tojin-machi" station (210 JPY). Hilton Fukuoka Sea Hawk is 20-minute walk from the station.

2) Direction from Hakata Area to Hilton Fukuoka Sea Hawk



By Bus: From Hakata, get on the bus bound for "Fukuoka Tower TNC (#306)" or to "Fujisaki (#306)" at "Hakata bus terminal" bus stop (1F, #6) and get off at "Hilton Fukuoka Sea Hawk-mae" bus stop.

The hotel is a one-minute walk from the bus stop. Approximately 17-minute ride from the bus stop.

By Subway: take the Fukuoka City Subway, getting off at "Tojin-machi" station (260 JPY). Hilton Fukuoka Sea Hawk is 20-minute walk from the station.
