# Suggested Elements to be Included in a Conservation and Management Measure for Pacific Bluefin Tuna CDS

## **Explanatory Note**

At the 4<sup>th</sup> CDS Technical Meeting, the participants requested that Korea produce a paper, based on the past documents, on elements to be included in a CMM, and submit it to the Small Working Group for further discussion (paragraph 9 of the Chair's Summary of the 4<sup>th</sup> CDS Technical Meeting).

This paper has considered past discussions on the scope and functions of a draft CMM for the development of CDS, which led to the agreement that such a CMM would:

- i. not include seafood traceability and not go beyond the scope of the bluefin tuna CDSs utilized by the CCSBT and ICCAT, and
- ii. not include specific monitoring, controlling and surveillance measures.

This paper suggests thirteen (13) elements to be included in a WCPFC CDS CMM, with potential discussion points for each element:

- 1. General Provisions and Application
- 2. Registers Required
- 3. Documents and Information Required
- 4. Tagging
- 5. Validation
- 6. Data Sharing and Confidentiality
- 7. Verification
- 8. Communication
- 9. Interaction with Domestic Program
- 10. Exceptional Arrangements
- 11. Implementation and Review

- 12. Reconciliation process for any data discrepancies
- 13. CDS Forms (Annexes)

High-level discussions on the principle and key points will lay the foundation for drafting a CMM that meets the need for a CDS in the context of the WCPFC.
