## Proposed Amendment to Conservation and Management Measure for Pacific Bluefin Tuna

IATTC-NC-JWG09-2024/DP-19

New Zealand and Australia

4. CCMs, not described in paragraph 3, may increase their catch of Pacific bluefin tuna 30kg or larger by 15% above their 2002-2004 annual average levels. CCMs with a base line catch of 10 tons or less of Pacific bluefin tuna 30 kg or larger may increase their catch as long as it does not exceed 10 metric tons per year. <u>The catch limit of Pacific bluefin tuna 30 kg or larger for New Zealand shall be 250 metric tonnes per year and for Australia 50 metric tonnes per year<sup>1</sup>.</u>
