Draft Terms of Reference for a WCPFC-IATTC Joint Working Group on South Pacific Albacore

WCPFC-IATTC South Pacific Albacore Joint Working Group Preliminary Draft Terms of Reference

Purpose

To establish a South Pacific Albacore Joint Working Group (SPA-JWG) to enhance cooperation between WCPFC and the Inter-American Tropical Tuna Commission (IATTC) for South Pacific albacore tuna research and management. The SPA-JWG will endeavour to develop recommendations for consideration by both Commissions regarding scientific cooperation and as appropriate, harmonized or coordinated management of SPA across the range of the stock.

Objectives

The objectives of the SPA-JWG are to:

- develop a common understanding of the management objectives for SPA in both convention areas;
- coordinate, conduct and promote scientific and economic analyses and also, [encourage] [facilitate] the collection and exchange of relevant fisheries data, knowledge and expertise [in a consistent manner] on areas pertinent to the sustainable management of SPA;
- enhance the harmonization of harvest strategies through, inter alia, the development of a joint workplan;
- identify [priority] areas for improvement in monitoring, reporting, and data sharing;
- advise on the development and maintenance of compatible management arrangements [to implement aligned harvest strategies] for SPA across all fisheries, including the coordination of catch and/or effort levels between the two Commissions;
- collaborate to identify ways to streamline the timelines of technical and decisionmaking sessions to ensure efficient progress towards the robust management of SPA. This should include opportunities for [recommending] intersessional decision-making where necessary [and any other matters as determined by both Commissions].

Timeline

To be developed.

Workplan

In 2025, an introductory informal session [may be held between WCPFC and IATTC] to commence the development of a joint workplan to achieve the objectives of the SPA-JWG.

Special requirements of SIDS

Funding support must be provided for at least one person from each SIDS¹ delegation.
