The Twenty-First Regular Session of the Northern Committee (NC21) of the Commission for the Conservation and Management of Highly Migratory Fish Stocks in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean (WCPFC) will be held at WOHLFAHRT TOYAMA, Toyama prefecture of Japan, from 14 (Monday) to 15 (Tuesday) July 2025. NC21, chaired by Mr Masanori Miyahara (Japan), will start at 9:00 am daily, with registration beginning at 8:00 am.

The Fisheries Agency of Japan will use them to communicate with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan so that it can send formal instructions to the Embassy or Consulate General of Japan for a smooth issuance of your visa.

Should you need a letter of invitation, letter of guarantee, list of visa applicants, etc., from the host country, please inform us too when you send the aforementioned email to the meeting coordinator.

Climate

In Toyama, July is typically hot, humid, and occasionally rainy, as it marks the peak of summer with lingering effects of the rainy season (tsuyu) in early July. Average temperatures range from 22–32°C (72–90°F), with high humidity levels around 70–80%, making it feel even warmer. While the month sees a mix of sunny and cloudy days, occasional rain showers or thunderstorms can occur. Light coastal breezes may offer some relief, but the heat and humidity can be intense, so staying hydrated and using sun protection is recommended.

Funding for Developing Countries and Territories

According to the decision made by WCPFC9, funding will be provided for travel to the NC21 meeting, including the JWG-10 meeting (9–12 July 2025), for six small island developing States. Priority will be given to RMI, FSM, and Palau, in addition to the Cook Islands, Fiji, and Vanuatu, who are already Members of the Northern Committee.

Formal nominations for participants requesting this support must be submitted to the Secretariat (<u>Aaron.Nighswander@wcpfc.int</u>) **by 1 June 2025**. Submissions must be signed by the WCPFC Official Contact for eligible developing countries and participating territories.

The latest travel arrangements for nominees should be finalized two weeks before commencing travel.
