CATCHES OF BIGEYE AND YELLOWFIN TUNA IN "OTHER FISHERIES"

Oceanic Fisheries Programme Secretariat of the South Pacific Commission Noumea, New Caledonia The Commission's Conservation and Management Measure 2005-01 made the following request of the Scientific Committee:

The second meeting of the Scientific Committee will review the catch of bigeye and yellowfin in other commercial fisheries in the Convention Area and provide advice to the Commission so that conservation and management measures can be developed.

The reference to "other fisheries" here is interpreted to mean those fisheries not addressed specifically by CMM 2005–01, i.e. fisheries other than longline and tropical (20°N–20°S) purse seine. These other fisheries are specified in Table 1 in terms of gear type and flag.

Catches provided in Table 1 are taken from annual catch estimates as given in the Tuna Fishery Yearbook (http://www.spc.int/oceanfish/Docs/Statistics/TYB.htm), updated and revised as appropriate based on recent submissions of annual catch estimates.

Notes:

- 1. Catch estimates in parentheses have been carried over from previous years.
- 2. French Polynesia 'pole-and-line' catches include the *bonitier* and *poti marara* fleets; both use various gear types (pole-and-line, troll, handline, harpoon, gill net).
- 3. Japan purse seine is north of 20°N.
- 4. Unclassified Indonesian catches of yellowfin in 2004 are considerably reduced because these catches were attributed to other gear types, mainly purse seine. This may suggest that unclassified catches prior to 2004 also contain large components by purse seine.
