In accordance with the Commission Rules of Procedure, Members, cooperating Members and Participating Territories (CCMs) are invited to attend the Fifth Meeting of the Northern Committee (NC5) of the Commission for the Conservation and Management of Highly Migratory Fish Stocks in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean.

The NC5 meeting will take place in Nagasaki, Japan, 7-10 September 2009. The meeting venue will be the Nagasaki Brick Hall (please see details regarding accommodation arrangements).

Wireless Internet will be available at the meeting room.


Transportation from the Nagasaki Airport to the hotels

To reach the above hotels from the Nagasaki Airport (http://www.nabic.co.jp/english/), it is recommended that participants take an airport shuttle bus bound for "Mori-Machi" at the Airport bus terminal No.5. It takes about 45 minutes and the fee is \forall 800 (for one way) or \forall 1,200 (for round-trip). The nearest bus stop for each hotel is as follows;

The Hotel New Nagasaki - "Nagasaki Station.",

The Best Western Premier Hotel Nagasaki - "Takara-Machi".
