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**Summary of the Reports Received Under Tropical Tuna CMMs from 2024 to 2026**

**Purpose**

1. This paper provides TCC22 with a summary of reports submitted by CCMs under the *Conservation and Management Measure for Bigeye, Yellowfin and Skipjack* ([CMM 2023-01](#) for 2024 and 2025, and [CMM 2025-02](#) for 2026). The paper reflects recent information received by the Secretariat. It should be noted that some information related to CCM responses to the draft Compliance Monitoring Report (dCMR) and recent reporting may not yet be reflected.

## CCM Notifications on the Application of Measures in the WCPFC–IATTC Overlap Area

### 4. The applicable WCPFC decisions and notes on the WCPFC – IATTC Overlap Area are as follows:

(a) The WCPFC9 decision on the application of measures in the part of the WCPF Convention Area that overlaps with the IATTC Convention Area says that in the case of a WCPFC member who is also an IATTC member, and who has vessels on both records/register of IATTC and WCPFC, the corresponding flag Member shall decide and notify both organisations under which of the two Commission measures those vessels shall operate when fishing in the overlap area with IATTC and WCPFC. If a CCM is a member of only one RFMO, the rules of that RFMO will apply in the overlap area between WCPFC and IATTC, even if the CCM is a cooperating non-member of the other RFMO. (see WCPFC9 Summary Report, paragraph 80)

(b) CMM 2021-01 paragraph 10 states that:

“Where flag CCMs choose to implement IATTC measures in the overlap area, any calculation of limits for the Convention Area (excluding the overlap area) that are done on the basis of historical catch or effort levels, shall exclude historical catch or effort within the overlap area. Notwithstanding decisions on application of catch and/or effort limits, all other provisions of this measure apply to all vessels fishing in the overlap area.”

### 5. In 2022, the Secretariat received two updates of Member’s choice of WCPFC/IATTC measures in the Overlap Area, and no updates were received in 2023, 2024, 2025, or 2026.<sup>25</sup> Accordingly, in 2022 - 2026, or as otherwise specified the following five CCMs could apply IATTC measures in the Overlap Area:<sup>26</sup>

- Ecuador – As a WCPFC Cooperating Non-Member which is a contracting party of IATTC;
- El Salvador – As a WCPFC Cooperating Non-Member which is a contracting party of IATTC;
- Panama – As a WCPFC Cooperating Non-Member which is a contracting party of IATTC;
- European Union – In accordance with letter received by WCPFC on 2 April 2013; and
- United States of America – In accordance with letter received by WCPFC on 8 July 2020.

## CCM Notifications of Increased Bigeye Longline Catch Limits and Associated Observer Coverage

### 6. In 2024, the Secretariat received notifications from two CCMs relating to an increase in their respective bigeye longline catch limit together with the commitment to apply a proportionate increase in observer coverage level (e.g., observer + Electronic Monitoring (EM)) above the minimum 5% ROP coverage level<sup>27</sup>:

- **Republic of Korea** – will increase its bigeye tuna catch limit by 10% in 2024, through achieving the necessary increase in observer coverage with human observer and EM coverage.

- **Chinese Taipei** – will increase its bigeye tuna longline catch limit by 2% in 2024, with a commitment to increase collective observer coverage by the end of 2024 from 5% to 6%.
7. In 2025, the Secretariat received notifications from three CCMs relating to an increase in their respective bigeye longline catch limit together with the commitment to apply a proportionate increase in observer coverage level (e.g., observer + Electronic Monitoring (EM)) above the minimum 5% ROP coverage level:
- **China** – will increase its bigeye tuna catch limit by 10% in 2025, by committing to maintain a minimum of 5% observer coverage under the ROP through human observers and increasing an additional 5% coverage through EM systems or human observers.
  - **Republic of Korea** – will increase its bigeye tuna catch limit by 10% in 2025.
  - **Chinese Taipei** – will increase its bigeye tuna longline catch limit by 2% in 2025, by committing that the collective observer coverage by the WCPO, combining LTLL and STLL, will be increased from 5% to 6% by the end of 2025. Chinese Taipei also advised that the additional 1% coverage is to be achieved by deployment of human observers from authorised ROP programme.
8. In 2026, the Secretariat received notifications from one CCM relating to an increase in their respective bigeye longline catch limit together with the commitment to apply a proportionate increase in observer coverage level (e.g., observer + Electronic Monitoring (EM)) above the minimum 5% ROP coverage level:
- **Chinese Taipei** – will increase its bigeye tuna longline catch limit by 2%, by committing that the collective observer coverage for longliners in the WCPO will be increased from 5% to 6% by the end of 2026. Chinese Taipei also advised that the additional 1% coverage is to be achieved by deployment of human observers from authorised ROP programme.

### Monthly Reporting of Bigeye Longline Catches

10. In relation to limits on purse seine activities in EEZs, in 2024, the Secretariat received notifications (under [CMM 2023-01 paragraph 24](#) footnote 2) from two CCMs advising they do not have established purse seine fisheries taking skipjack, yellowfin or bigeye tuna within their EEZs. Accordingly, the [CMM 2023-01 paragraph 24](#) provisions do not apply to: **French Polynesia** and **Republic of Korea**. In 2025 and 2026, no new notifications were received of EEZ limits for purse seine effort and/or catch of skipjack, yellowfin and bigeye tuna.

#### Recommendation
