ISSUES:

1. Article 14(1) of the Convention provides the scope of TCC work. WCPFC5 and WCPFC6 have provided several priority issues for TCC, as did TCC6. The Commissioners are invited to review these earlier priorities and provide direction for TCC for 2011-2013.

ADVICE AND RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2. Using discussions in WCPFC5, WCPFC6 and TCC6 as a guide, the proposed technical and compliance elements of the Commission's Work Program for 2011-2013 is based on the three functions of the TCC identified in Article 14 of the Convention, and are presented in **Attachment 1**.
- 3. Some work program elements may be accomplished "in-house' and at nominally zero cost, whereas others may require outside expertise and significant financial support and are reflected in the proposed budget presented at FAC4.
- 4. WCPFC7 is invited to review, discuss and confirm priorities for TCC for 2011-2013 in the following matrix based on Article 14 (1) of the WCPFC Convention.
