Information Paper (IP): Papers considered by Theme Group Conveners and the Chair as an information paper should be of general interest – a supplementary paper circulated for information only – not requiring presentation in the plenary but may be referred to in discussion. Relevant conveners should attach a cover page, assign a unique number and send it to the Secretariat (WCPFC-SC9-2013/EB-IP-XX).
