Transportation from the Fukuoka Airport to the hotels

Transportation from the Fukuoka Airport to Hilton Fukuoka Sea Hawk is available by:

- Taxi approximately 20 minute drive from the airport (approximately 4,000 JPY).
- Bus get on the bus to Fukuoka Tower Minamiguchi TNC (#39) and get off at Sea Hawk-mae bus stop (420 JPY). The hotel is one minutes walk from the bus stop. Approximately 40 minutes ride from the airport.
- Subway take the Fukuoka City Subway, getting off at Tojin-machi Station (290 JPY). Hilton Fukuoka Sea Hawk is 20-minute walk from the station.
 Approximately 15 minute subway ride from the airport.
