WCPFC-SC7-2011/06

The SC7 participants and researchers who want to submit papers should submit titles and abstracts by **July 4**, and full papers by **July 22**. Author(s) should advise which theme their paper has been prepared for. The Theme Conveners, Chair and Vice-Chair will be responsible for accepting or rejecting a paper, and if accepted, directing the Secretariat to post the paper as either a *working paper* or an *information paper*.

Working papers: Papers judged by Theme Convener, the Chair and Vice-Chair should be directly relevant to a specific agenda item, and will support substantive discussion. E.g. WCPFC-SC7-2011/EB-WP-XX

Information papers: papers judged by Theme Group Convener, the Chair and Vice-Chair to be of general interest – a supplementary paper circulated for information only – not requiring presentation in the Plenary but may be referred to in discussion. E.g. WCPFC-SC7-2011/EB-IP-XX
