MOW3-WINF/01 15 October 2014

The Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission (WCPFC) at its 10th Regular Session agreed to hold an additional workshop on management options (MOW3) in 2014. This workshop would be held immediately prior to the 11th Regular Session of the WCPFC. Subsequent meetings of SC10 and TCC recommended that MOW3 should consider a proposed CMM on Harvest Control Rules and a PNA draft CMM on a target reference point for skipjack tuna.

MOW3 will be held in Apia, Samoa on Friday 28th November 2014.

Ian Cartwright, who facilitated the previous two Management Objective Workshops, continues to support the process by facilitating MOW3.
