The Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission (WCPFC) at its 10<sup>th</sup> Regular Session agreed to hold an additional workshop on management options (MOW3) in 2014. This workshop would be held immediately prior to the 11<sup>th</sup> Regular Session of the WCPFC. Subsequent meetings of SC10 and TCC recommended that MOW3 should consider a proposed CMM on Harvest Control Rules and a PNA draft CMM on a target reference point for skipjack tuna.

MOW3 will be held in Apia, Samoa on Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2014.

Ian Cartwright, who facilitated the previous two Management Objective Workshops, continues to support the process by facilitating MOW3.
