Good morning Feleti and Lara,

Please find outlined below New Zealand's catch levels for Pacific Bluefin Tuna under CMM2014-04 (para 5). Apologies for lateness.

Pacific Bluefin Tuna is managed under the quota management system. The Total Allowable Catch is 145 tonne (of which 116 tonnes is for commercial catch) which is the current baseline for the New Zealand EEZ). Total catch for the past five years including 2013 and 2014 is detailed below:

Pacific Bluefin (tonnes)	14	28	13	24	12

2001-04 average is 55 tonnes and all are over 30kg.
