Meeting Notice for the Twelfth Regular Session of the Commission for the Conservation and Management of Highly Migratory Fish Stocks in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean

Dear All,

Members, Cooperating Non-Members and Participating Territories (CCMs) are invited to attend the Twelfth Regular Session of the Commission for the Conservation and Management of Highly Migratory Fish Stocks in the Western and Central Pacific Ocean (WCPFC12) and associated meetings.

It was agreed that WCPFC12 would take place in Bali, Indonesia from Thursday, 3 December to Tuesday, 8 December, with Wednesday 2 December reserved to start the Ninth Session of the Finance and Administration Committee and the Heads of Delegation meeting. The meeting venue will be The Stones hotel in Kuta, Bali Indonesia.

The fourth Management Objectives Workshop will be held at the same venue on Monday November 30 and Tuesday December 1. Further advice on this meeting will be forthcoming.

Meeting Documents

The preliminary documents for the meeting will be updated in due course; mindful of the 30-day deadline for papers.

In consultation with the WCPFC Chair, the Executive Director will very shortly be drawing up the provisional agenda for WCPFC12. Commission Members that may wish to propose items for inclusion on the WCPFC12 agenda should advice the Executive Director Feleti Teo (Feleti.Teo@wcpfc.int) and WCPFC Chair Rhea Moss-Christian (rhea.christian@wcpfc.int), preferably by Sunday 4 October.

The Commission agreed in good faith that, despite Rule 20 of the Rules of Procedure that requires 24 hours' notice, Members would try to submit draft proposals 30 days prior to the Annual Session of the Commission in order to allow all Members adequate time for consideration and consultation.

Any Member of the Commission, the Chairman, or the Executive Director may, at least 30 days before the date for the opening of the Regular Session request the inclusion of supplementary items in the Agenda. A request for the inclusion of a supplementary item in the Provisional Agenda shall be accompanied by a written explanation of the proposed supplementary item, which will be communicated to all CCMs and observers at least 20 days before the opening of the Session.

VISA ARRANGEMENT ENTERING INDONESIA Prepared by Directorate General of Capture Fisheries Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries, Republic of Indoensia

1. Visa Arrangements

All visitors to Indonesia are required to posses a passport that is valid, with the expiration date of the passport must be at least 6 (six) months prior on the date of entry into the territory of Indonesia.

Passport must contain at least two blank visa pages. The amendment and endorsement pages at the back of the passport does not generally count as blank page and cannot be used for visa and stamp for entry permit purposes.

It is strongly recommended that visitors obtain a valid visa before departure and are advised to submit their visa application as early as possible at least 4 (four) weeks prior to the intended date of entry, at the Embassies and Consultates of the Republic of Indonesia abroad. The list of the Embassies and Consultates of Republic of Indonesia and their addresses are available at website http://kemlu.go.id/Pages/Mission.aspx?/=en.

For visa application, please provide a letter from government agency/institution which describes the purpose of the visit. Application form must be completed with recent colour photographs (passport size) and copy of flight ittenaries or tickets and signed by the applicant. The application form can be obtained at the Indonesian Embassies and Consulates. Please be advised that visa to Indonesia must be used within 90 (ninety) days from the date of issuance.

Visa applications will be processed by Indonesian Embassies and Consulates once all required documents are completed. Please note that the letter of invitation to the 12th Regular Session of the Commission for Western and Central Pasific Fisheries Commission (WCPFC) does not automatically guarantee the issuance of visa for entry into the Indonesian territory.

Holders of diplomatic and service passports are recommended to apply the required visas to Indonesian embassises and consulate accredited to their respected countries.

Some participants are not required to have a visa to enter Indonesian territory in accordance with Indonesian regulations. The Visa Waiver Programs of the Government of the Republic of Indonesia are as follows:

a. Visa Free Entry waives nationals from 15 countries/entities holders of all type of Passports, from the visa requirements to enter the territory of Indonesia for a short visit of up to 30 days.

 b. Visa Exemption for Diplomatic and Official/Service Passport Holders waives nationals from 50 countries holders of Diplomatic and Official or Service Passports, from the visa requirements to enter the territory of Indonesia for a short visit.

The Government of Indonesia offers a facility of Visa on Arrival for short visit not exceeding 30 days for nationals from 66 countries/entity which can be applied on arrival at the Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, Jakarta and at the Ngurah Rai International Airport, Bali. Visa on Arrival is subject to USS\$ 35 fee, payable by cash on arrival. Should the participant, holders of a diplomatic and official or service passports, including all ministers or head of delegations, wish to apply for a Visa on Arrival, the said fee shall apply and be borne on them. Bank facilities are available next to the Visa on Arrival desk in the Airport arrivals area for those who need to exchange money to pay the fee. Visa on Arrival is not convertible to other types of visas.

Nationals from other countries not include on list in para 1 (a) (b) and (c) or countries where there is no Indonesian Embassies and Consulates, will need to apply for a visa at the nearest Indonesian Embassies and Consulates to their country of residence or request to apply conditional Visa on Arrival to the Government of the Republic of Indonesia. Should the participant wish to apply conditional visa arrival, delegation coordinators representing the countries are reminded that they must submit an official note to the Indonesian 12th

Regular Session of the Commission for Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission (WCPFC) Organizing Committee with its delegate's full name, nationality, passport number and passport's date of expiry, in order to be eligible of this conditional arrangement. A Letter of Guarantee (LOG) will subsequently be provided confirming this conditional Visa on Arrival arrangement. For this conditional arrangement, delegation coordinators are advised to submit the application **(template enclosed)** as early as possible at least 6 (six) weeks prior to the intended date of entry, to:
