## **COOPERATING NON-MEMBER REQUESTS FOR 2016**

WCPFC12-2015-08<sup>1</sup> 13 November 2015

## Paper by the WCPFC Secretariat

# Purpose

1. The paper presents for the consideration and decision of WCPFC12 the requests received for grant of Cooperating Non-Member (CNM) status for 2016.

## **Background**

- 2. The Sixth Regular Session of the Commission (WCPFC6) adopted Conservation and Management Measure 2009-11 (CMM 2009-11) 'Cooperating Non-Members' (which replaced CMM 2008-02 and before that CMM 2004-02). The decisions to be made by the Commission are set out in paragraphs 8 and 12-13, which is a two-step process:
  - 8. The Commission shall accord CNM status on an annual basis. It may renew the CNM status subject to a review of the CNM's compliance with the Convention's objectives and requirements.
  - 12. Without prejudice to the sovereign rights of coastal States for the purpose of exploring and exploiting, conserving and managing highly migratory fish stocks within areas under national jurisdiction, and following the granting of CNM status, the Commission shall, where necessary, determine how the participatory rights of CNMs will be limited by the conservation and management measures adopted by the Commission. ...
  - 13. The limits determined for CNMs under paragraph 12 may be reviewed by the Commission from time to time in accordance with this measure and other conservation and management measures adopted by the Commission.

The WCPFC6 Summary Report includes as Attachment S a flowchart that was intended to illustrate the CMM 2009-11 process (see **Appendix 1**)

3. On 19 February 2015, the WCPFC Secretariat sent to all 2015 Cooperating Non-Members, letters confirming the outcomes from WCPFC11 in regard to their CNM

request and where applicable, the financial commitment expected from each CNM for 2015. The link to the template electronic form to be used for CNM applications to renew status for 2016 was also provided: https://www.wcpfc.int/doc/commission-07b/cooperating-non-member-request-template.

- 4. The Secretariat received seven (7) requests for grant of Cooperating Non-Member status in 2016, all were submitted using the electronic pdf form (see **Table 1** on next page). A few requesting countries also provided a written cover letter to support their CNM request. **Table 2** provides an update on payment of financial contributions.
- 5. A copy of the information that was submitted by CNM applicants is accessible to CCMs through their individual logins to the CCM section of the WCPFC website (https://www.wcpfc.int/cooperating-non-members) with the reference as WCPFC-WCPFC-TCC11-2015-08 Attachment 1 to this paper. The information submitted on the pdf form, has been extracted and is provided combined CSV format with the reference as WCPFC-TCC11-2015-08 Attachment 2 to this paper. Copies of letters and communications related to WCPFC11 outcomes are also provided on the CCM section with reference as WCPFC-TCC11-2015-08 Attachment 1.

### TCC11 outcomes

- 6. TCC11 reviewed the compliance status of six current Cooperating Non-Members (Ecuador, El Salvador, Mexico, Panama, Thailand and Vietnam). These compliance reviews took place alongside compliance reviews of Members and Participating Territories, as part of the Compliance Monitoring Scheme process (CMM 2014-07).
- 7. During October, the Secretariat sent letters to all CNM Applicants to forwarding TCC11 outcomes (CMM 2009-11 paragraph 4). Copies of these letters and relevant additional information received post-TCC11 are also provided on the CCM section as **Attachment 3**. A list of all CNM-related documents will be maintained as part of the WCPFC12 List of Documents (WCPFC12-2015-04).
- 8. It is expected that a working group will be established to prepare draft decisions points for consideration by WCPFC12 relevant to any reviews of Cooperating Non-Member participatory limits.

### Recommendation

9. WCPFC12 is invited to decide with respect to each Cooperating Non-Member applicant whether to accord Cooperating Non-Member status.


Was the application to request CNM status (new or renewal) submitted in English at least 60 days before the TCC? (Para. 1)



The TCC considers all applications that met the deadline. It may consider those that did not, as appropriate.

The <u>TCC assesses</u> whether the applications includes all the information required (Para. 3a) and has fulfilled the requirements of paragraph 3.

The <u>TCC provides recommendations and technical advice</u> on the applications, using criteria in paragraph 3, to the Commission.



<u>CNMs</u> are entitled to participate in Commission and subsidiary body meetings as an observer (Para. 10).

<u>CNMs</u> shall comply with the requirements of Paras. 9 and 11 and be invited by the Commission to make financial contributions (Para. 14).

The Commission shall monitor the activities and compliance of CNMs and shall take appropriate action against CNMs deemed to have undermined CMMs. (Paras. 15 and 16).
