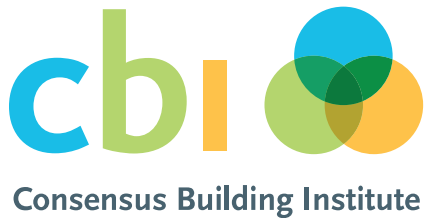

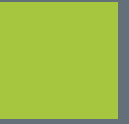


Consultation Meeting Objectives

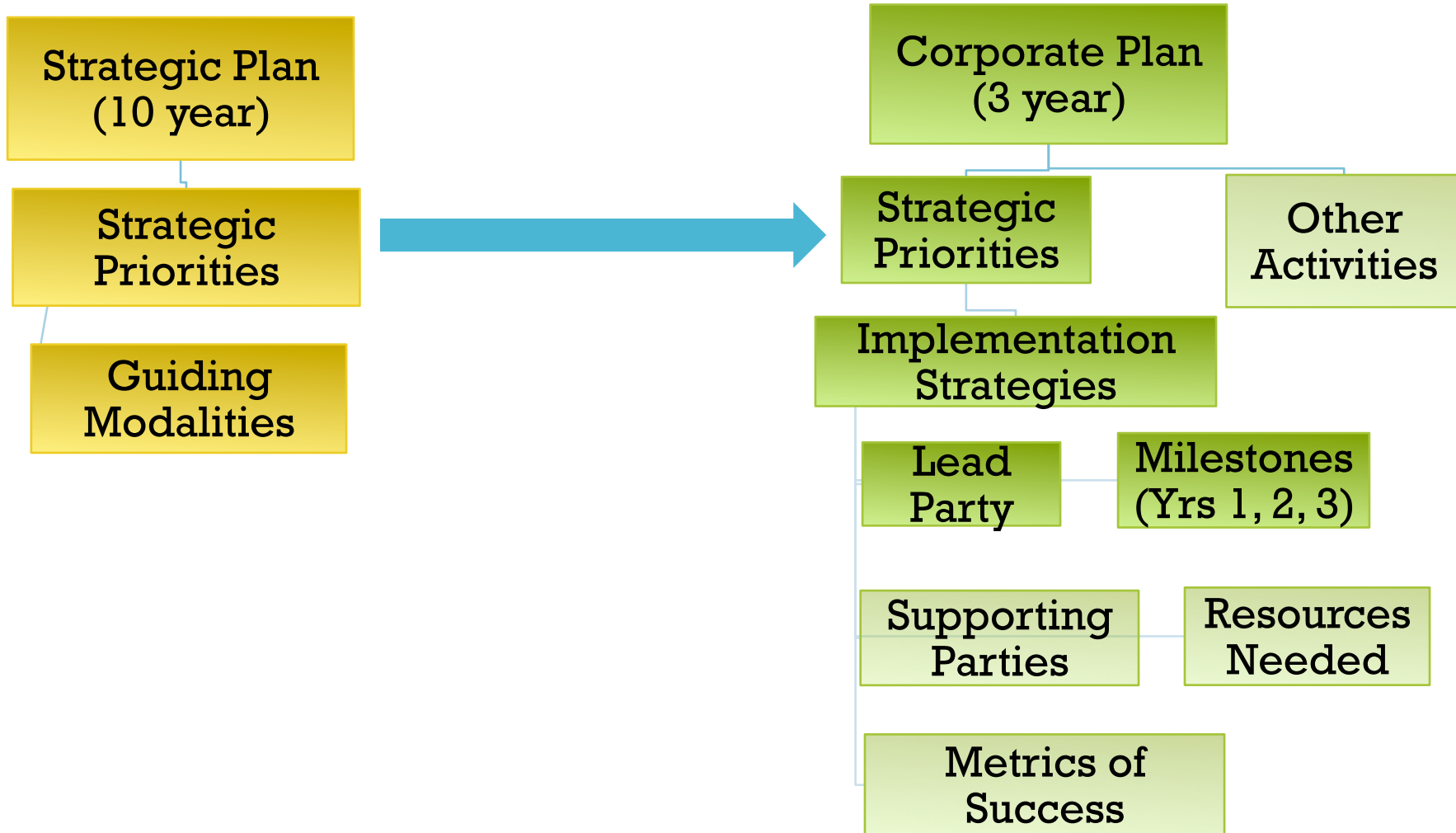

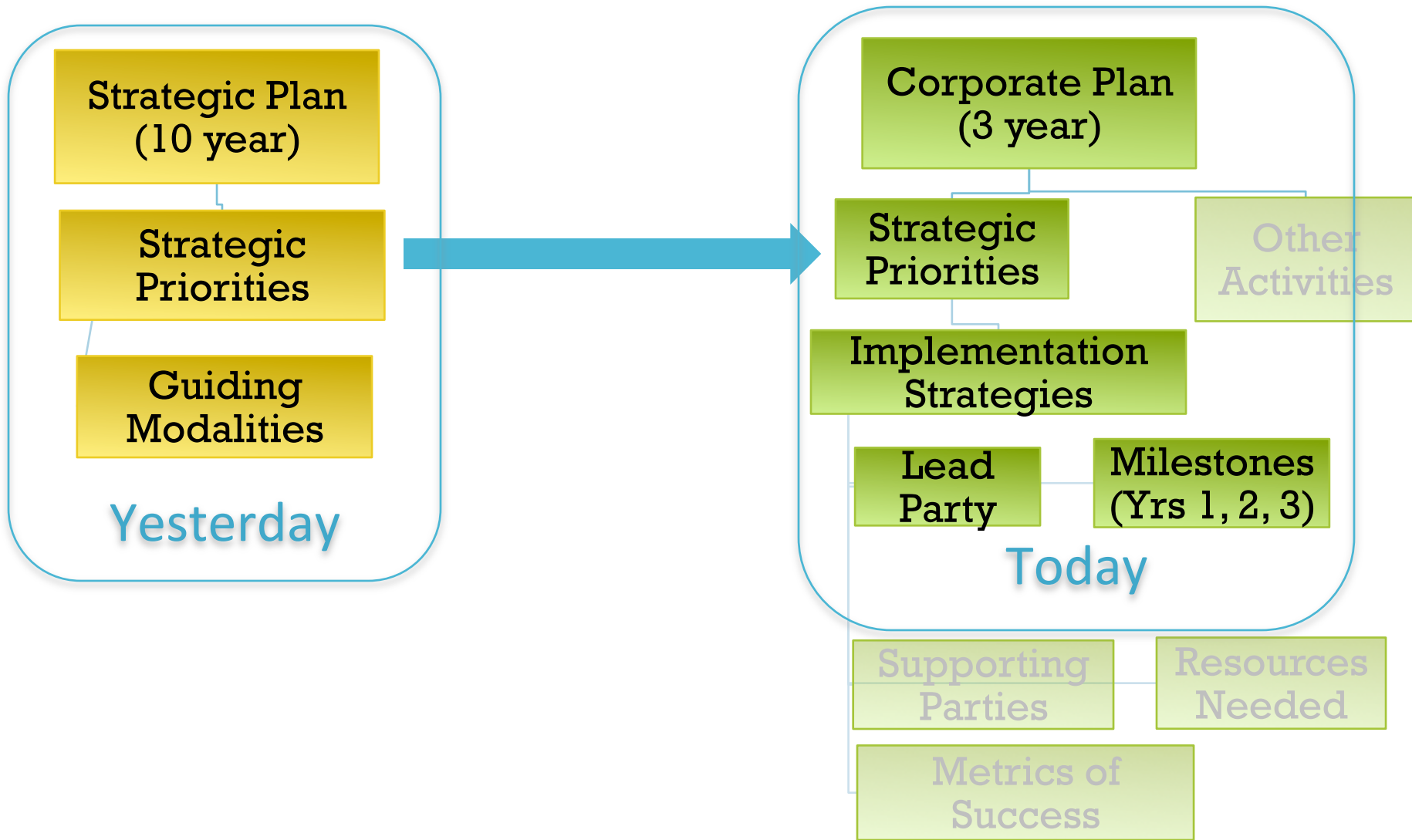

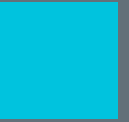
