## PROPOSAL ON PURSE SEINE EFFORT LIMITS

## **Explanatory Notes to Purse Seine Fishing Effort Limits Table**

- 1. Each CCM (or specified group of CCMs) would have an annual limit on the number of fishing days that may be spent by purse seine vessels of any flag in its EEZ (or in its group of EEZs) and by purse seine fishing vessels under its flag (or their flags) on the high seas. The limits would apply between the latitudes of 20° N and 20° S.
- 2. The extent to which a CCM's limit may be used on the high seas by purse seine vessels under another flag, either through chartering, transfer or sale, would be subject to further deliberation.
- 3. Each CCM (or group of CCMs) would be responsible for ensuring that the annual limit is not exceeded. In the case of a collective limit for a specified group of CCMs, compliance with the limit would be a collective responsibility, and all CCMs in the group would be considered non-compliant if the group is found non-compliant.
