# **CNM REQUESTS FOR 2019**

WCPFC-TCC14-2018-07 28 August 2018

### Paper by the WCPFC Secretariat

### Purpose

1. The paper presents for the consideration and decision of TCC14 the requests received for grant of Cooperating Non-Member (CNM) status for 2019.

### Background

2. On 29 March 2018, the WCPFC Secretariat sent to all 2017 CNM applicants, letters confirming the outcomes from WCPFC14 in regard to their CNM requests and the financial commitment expected from each CNM for 2018. Attention was also drawn in the letter to the latest version of the electronic form to be used when requesting for grant of CNM status in 2019.<sup>1</sup>

3. To date, the Secretariat has received eight (8) requests for grant of CNM status in 2019, some were submitted using the 2017 version of the electronic pdf form (see **Table 1** below). One CNM request was submitted as a scanned document, so was not able to be directly imported into the combined csv format. The Secretariat has reproduced the submission from this CNM into the correct e-format to allow for a complete combined csv format to be generated. A few requesting countries also provided a written cover letter to support their CNM request.

4. **Table 2** provides an update on payment of financial contributions for 2018 as at 8 August 2018.

Copies of letters and communications related to WCPFC14 outcomes are also provided on the CCM section with reference as **Attachment 1**.

6. The WCPFC Secretariat has prepared a draft Compliance Monitoring Report covering 2017 activities for seven current CNMs (Ecuador, El Salvador, Mexico, Liberia, Panama, Thailand and Vietnam). As was the case in past years, the information for CNMs are expected to be considered alongside the draft Compliance Monitoring Reports of Members and Participating Territories, and as part of the Compliance Monitoring Scheme process (CMM 2017-07).

## Recommendation

7. TCC14 is invited to consider the requests for CNM status for 2019 and make recommendations and technical advice to the Commission. It is expected that a working group will develop draft recommendations for TCC14 to consider.
