## Provisions of CMM 2017-01 requiring review at WCPFC15

## Conservation and Management Measure for Bigeye, Yellowfin and Skipjack Tuna Provisions of CMM 2017-01 requiring review at WCPFC15

This paper sets out those provisions which should be reviewed at WCPFC15.

- A. Provisions applicable for one year only, either as set out in paragraph 56 of CMM 2017-01, or according to their terms:
  - Footnote 1 (Cook Islands' high seas purse seine charter exception)
  - Paragraph 16 (3 month FAD closure).
  - Paragraph 17 (additional 2 month high seas FAD closure).
  - Paragraph 29 (US transfer of 100 days to its high seas effort limit).
  - Paragraph 39 and Table 3 of Attachment 1 (bigeye longline catch limits).
- B. Provisions which CMM 2017-01 requires to be reviewed at WCPFC15
  - Paragraph 15 requires review of paragraphs 12 to 14 in light of advice of SC.
  - Paragraph 22 requires consideration of adoption of measures on the implementation of non-entangling and/or biodegradable material on FADs [paragraphs 19 and 20], based on guidelines developed by the FAD Management Options IWG and advice from SC14 and TCC14.
  - Paragraph 24 requires review of whether the number of FADs deployed as set out in paragraph 23 is appropriate, based on consideration in the FAD Management Options IWG.
  - Paragraph 40 requires review of the bigeye catch limits specified in Table 3 of Attachment 1, based on any revised stock assessments and the recommendations of the SC, and the Commission may also take into account any plan by a CCM to increase the level of monitoring and control of its longline vessels fishing in the Convention Area.
  - Paragraph 50 indicates that SC14 and TCC14 will provide advice to the Commission on other fisheries and what information is needed to develop appropriate management measures for those other fisheries.
- C. Additional provisions which have a timeframe set out in CMM 2017-01
  - Paragraph 25: Coastal CCMs that have yet to notify limits to the Commission shall do so by 31 December 2018.
  - Paragraph 28: agreement on purse seine effort or catch limits on the high seas and a framework for allocation of those limits by 2019 (ie at WCPFC16).
  - Paragraph 44: agreement on longline hard limits for bigeye and a framework to allocate those limits by 2020 (ie at WCPFC17).
