Working Paper (WP): Papers considered by Theme Conveners and the Chair as working papers should be <u>directly pertinent</u> to a specific agenda item, and support substantive discussion. Relevant conveners should attach a cover page, assign a unique number and send it to the Secretariat (example format: WCPFC-SC8-2012/EB-WP-XX).

Information Paper (IP): Papers considered by Theme Group Conveners and the Chair as information papers should be of <u>general interest</u> – supplementary papers circulated for information only – not requiring presentation in the plenary but possibly referred to in discussion. Relevant conveners should attach a cover page, assign a unique number and send it to the Secretariat (example format: WCPFC-SC8-2012/EB-IP-XX)
