# **CNM REQUESTS IN 2020**

## Paper by the Secretariat

### Purpose

1. The paper presents the requests received for Cooperating Non-Member (CNM) status for 2021 for the consideration and decision of TCC16.

## Background

2. On 26 March 2020, the Executive Director sent letters to all 2019 CNM applicants, confirming the outcomes from WCPFC16 in relation to their CNM requests and the financial commitment expected from each CNM for 2020. The letter also drew attention to the latest version of the electronic form to be used when requesting CNM status be granted for in 2021 which is available on the WCPFC website (at <a href="https://www.wcpfc.int/doc/commission-07b/cooperating-non-member-request-template">https://www.wcpfc.int/doc/commission-07b/cooperating-non-member-request-template</a> ).

## CNM requests for 2021

3. To date, the Secretariat has received ten (10) requests for grant of CNM status in 2021 (see **Table 1** below). A few requesting countries also provided a written cover letter to support their CNM request. All CNM applicants have submitted an electronic form.

7. The Secretariat has prepared a draft Compliance Monitoring Report covering 2019 activities for relevant seven current CNMs (Ecuador, El Salvador, Liberia, Nicaragua, Panama, Thailand and Vietnam). As has been the case in past years, the information for CNMs are expected to be considered alongside the draft Compliance Monitoring Reports of Members and Participating Territories, and as part of the Compliance Monitoring Scheme process (CMM 2019-06).

# Recommendation

8. TCC16 is invited to consider the requests for CNM status for 2021 and make recommendations and technical advice to the Commission. It is expected that a working group will develop draft recommendations for TCC16 to consider.
