MTU/ALC INSPECTION TEMPLATE AND PROPOSED REPORTING FORMAT

WCPFC-TCC8-2012-12 30 August 2012

PAPER PREPARED BY THE SECRETARIAT

1. CCMs are responsible for ensuring compliance by their flag vessels with the provisions of Annex I of CMM 2011-02 and the WCPFC VMS SSPs (SSPs 7.2.1). In addition CCMs are required to conduct periodic audits of a representative sample of installed ALCS to verify that the specification and standards as set out in Annex I are being complied with, and that there is no visible evidence of tampering (SSPs 2.9). CCMs are responsible for ensuring that the audits are conducted by qualified operatives, such as officers currently authorized under CCM national fisheries legislation. CCMs are to annual report results of ALC inspections, and provide to the Secretariat a list of ALC inspections by flag and vessel type, including a summary of the results of each inspection (SSPs 2.13 and 7.2.4).

2. TCC7 directed the Secretariat to prepare an ALC/MTU audit template checklist to assist CCMs with meeting the requirements of the WCPFC VMS SSPs. A draft audit template was prepared by the Secretariat for WCPFC8 (WCPFC8-2011-28 Rev 1). Attached is a further revised draft template which takes into account comments received from CCMs during WCPFC8.

3. A box titled VMS SSPs 7.2.4 was included by the Secretariat in the Part 2 Annual Report template for CCMs to report on 2011 activities. So that the Secretariat has sufficient information to produce a summary audit/inspection report based on information provided by CCMs, the following table is proposed for use by CCMs to provide annual summary information on MTU/ALC audits performed in the previous calendar year.
