7.1 General overview of status of WCPO stocks

The Commission will receive brief updates from the Scientific Services Provider (SSP) and ISC on the status of the WCPO tuna and billfish stocks to set the scene for this agenda.

7.2 Bigeye, Skipjack and Yellowfin

The Commission will consider the various issues concerning the management of the tropical tuna stocks with the main focus on the development of the new tropical tuna measure.

7.2.1 Harvest Strategy issues

With the main focus of WCPFC18 on the new tropical tuna measure, the Commission will consider these elements of the harvest strategy work plan as they relate the new tropical tuna measure.

7.2.1.1 Review target reference point for skipjack

The Commission will consider the advice and information from SC17 and the SSP on possible formulation of a target reference point for skipjack.

7.2.1.2 Review target reference point for bigeye and yellowfin

The Commission will consider the advice and information from SC17 and the SSP on possible formulation of target reference points for bigeye and yellowfin, including the results of further analysis requested by SC17 related to the impact of candidate bigeye and yellowfin TRPs on the SP albacore stock (Para 85, SC17 Outcomes Document).

7.2.1.3 Management procedures for skipjack

As required by the Indicative Work Plan for the Adoption of Harvest Strategy under CMM 2014-06, the Commission is expected to consider in 2021 management procedures for skipjack. With the focus on the new tropical tuna measure, the Commission may consider deferring this work to 2022.

7.2.2 Proposed New Measure for Tropical Tuna

The Chair will present the Chair's proposal for a new tropical tuna measure. The Chair's proposed new tropical tuna measure is a culmination of two dedicated workshops to develop a new tropical tuna measure and a series of intersessional consultations between and among CCMs and between the Chair and CCMs. The Commission will receive the following two reports, before working its way through the Chair's proposal.

7.2.2.1 SSP Analysis of Requests by TTMW2

The SSP will present the outcomes of its analysis of the requests that were provided to it by the second workshop to develop the new tropical tuna measure (TTMW2).

7.2.2.2 Report of the FAD-MO IWG

The Commission will consider the aspects of the report of the FAD Management Options Intersessional Working Group that relate to the FAD provisions of the new tropical tuna measure.

7.2.3 Other commercial fisheries for bigeye, skipjack and yellowfin

The Commission will consider the advice of SC17 and TCC17 on the implementation of paragraphs 50 and 51 of CMM 2020-01.

7.3 South Pacific Albacore

7.3.1 Review of the interim target reference point

The Commission will review the interim target reference point for South Pacific albacore taking into account the advice of SC17 (Para 27, SC17 Outcomes Document) related to a recalibration of the interim TRP in accordance with the process agreed at WCPFC15 (Para 207, WCPFC15 Summary Report).

7.3.2 Roadmap for effective conservation and management of SP albacore

The Commission will receive the report of the Intersessional Working Group tasked to develop the Roadmap for the effective conservation and management of the South Pacific albacore stock.

7.3.3 Review of CMM 2015-02

The Commission will be invited to review CMM 2015-02.

7.4 Pacific bluefin tuna

7.4.1 Review of CMM 2019-02

The Commission will be invited to review any updates on CMM 2019-02.

7.5 Southwest Pacific swordfish

The Commission will consider the SC17 advice and results of the future projections for Southwest Pacific swordfish as tasked by WCPFC16 (para 481, WCPFC16 Summary Report) and SC17 (para 69-71, SC17 Outcomes Document).

7.6 North Pacific Striped Marlin

7.6.1 Advice from the ISC

The Commission will assess the information and advice it requested the International Scientific Committee for Tuna and Tuna-like Species in the North Pacific Ocean at WCPFC17 concerning the stock status of the NP striped marlin.

7.6.2 Review of CMM 2010-01 and an Interim Rebuilding Plan

The Commission will be invited to review CMM 2010-01 and consider an Interim Rebuilding Plan for the NP striped marlin stock.

Dear Feleti,

First, the United States would like to submit to WCPFC18 the attached proposal to revise the shark CMM. We would appreciate you making this available to other delegations to WCPFC18.

Second, the United States would like to request a supplemental agenda item for WCPFC18 on North Pacific striped marlin, along the following lines:

North Pacific Striped Marlin

- (1) Requests to the ISC: The Commission will review responses from the ISC on requests made by WCPFC17.
- (2) Review of CMM 2010-01 and Interim Rebuilding Plan: The Commission is invited to review CMM 2010-01, and to discuss how to progress implementation of the Interim Rebuilding Plan for the North Pacific striped marlin stock adopted at WCPFC16.

To explain a little further: Regarding the first part, WCPFC17 made specific requests to the ISC regarding its assessment of NP striped marlin (see paragraph 250), and we understand the ISC is prepared to report back to the Commission. We also understand that the ISC is seeking clarification on one aspect of the interim rebuilding target that will help it provide the Commission with the best information going forward. We are prepared to offer specific suggestions for the Commission's consideration on that issue. Regarding the second part of the requested agenda item, we think it is important for CCMs to discuss this year how to make progress on rebuilding, even if no specific proposals are offered.

We don't anticipate this agenda item to take much time, particularly because we don't expect any proposals on the topic to be submitted (at least not from the United States).
